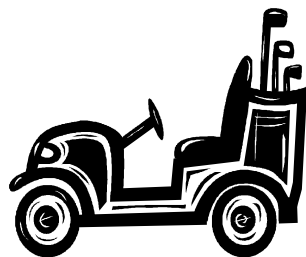
2012 PRIVATE GOLF CAR REGISTRATION

All private Golf Car Owners who registered their golf car in the 2005 season are grandfathered for as long as they meet the definition of "registered golf car driver."

Registered golf cars may be left in appropriate outside parking areas after March 20, 2012. Registered golf cars may be left in indoor parking areas after March 20, 2012.

Use of private golf cars will be allowed on the courses beginning March 20 –weather permitting through October 31, 2012. Golf cars stored inside at Ledges will be stored outside after October 31, 2012. Owners further agree to remove golf cars from the premises by November 6, 2012.

Premier golf cards and daily fees are available to resident and non-resident golfers for the same rate. Reserved starting times may be scheduled up to one week in advance by contacting the clubhouse. Playdays and tournaments are scheduled through the District Office by calling 815/877-6100. Each course has been rated by the Chicago District Golf Association (CDGA).
